## **Rules & Regulations:**

- Please refer to the current AQHA rulebook for tack, class scoring, and other competition information.
- **Show Office Notice:** The Show Office will briefly close at **8:45 AM** prior to the first class to finalize entries and paperwork. Any **day-of or last-minute entries/changes** must be completed **by 8:00 AM**. The Show Office will reopen at approximately **9:45 AM** (after the first class).
- Proper attire must be worn by all exhibitors. Please refer to the AQHA rulebook for more information on discipline-appropriate attire and tack.
- Riders under the age of 18 must wear a helmet at all times when mounted. Riders under the age of 18 must not be permitted to handle stallions.
- One horse may not compete “against itself” in one class. If multiple riders are using the same horse, each entry must be in a separate division.
- To increase access to this fun show, the same horse may be used by multiple competitors in the Showmanship classes-NOT in any riding classes.
- Horses of **any age** may be shown in either: A **snaffle bit with two hands, OR a shank (curb) bit with one hand**. This rule is intended to support training flexibility and rider safety while maintaining fair competition standards across all age groups and experience levels.
- **Overnight stalls are available** at a charge of \$60 for the weekend, including a \$25 deposit, which will be returned at departure if/when the stall is stripped.
  - Stall requests are not guaranteed after the entry deadline.
  - Stall requests must be made for the entire weekend.
  - Hay, shavings, water buckets, hooks, etc. must be provided by the horse owner/rider.
  - **RMHT is not responsible for any accidents, loss of property, damage to facilities, or otherwise for those using the showgrounds overnight. Supervision is the sole responsibility of the horse exhibitor/owner, and will not be provided by RMHT nor any volunteers.**
- Highpoints are awarded to horse and rider combinations accumulated according to page two in highlighter
- The judge has the authority to dismiss any participant from the competition at their discretion if the competitor, horse, or handler exhibits behavior that is unsafe,

unsportsmanlike, or otherwise detrimental to the integrity of the event. The judge's decision is final and not subject to appeal. No refunds will be issued in the event of dismissal.

- Early bird entries are due by 11:59 pm on June 12th. Each early entry will be submitted for a drawing of a free stall rental for the weekend. Any entries submitted after this date will be subject to a \$15 late fee.
- **Show Committee Authority** – The show management reserves the right to combine/cancel classes, or make adjustments to the schedule as needed.
- All participants, trainers, and spectators must conduct themselves professionally and respectfully. Disruptive behavior may result in dismissal.
- **Refund Policy** – No refunds are allowed due to scratches, vet notes, or weather cancellations.
- **Liability Waiver** –A signed waiver releasing the show, venue, and staff from liability in case of injury must be signed prior to show start. Waivers will be available at the show office.
- A two minute gate policy will be enforced unless arranged prior to the class.
- All participants riding on the fairgrounds must sign a waiver and pay an entry fee.
